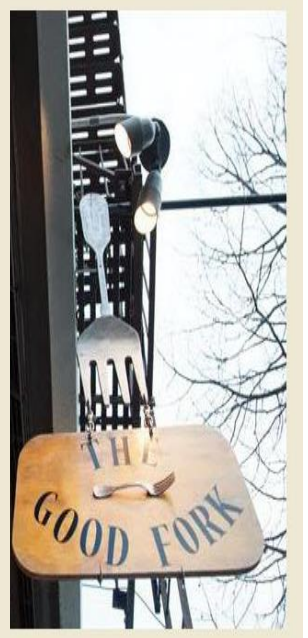
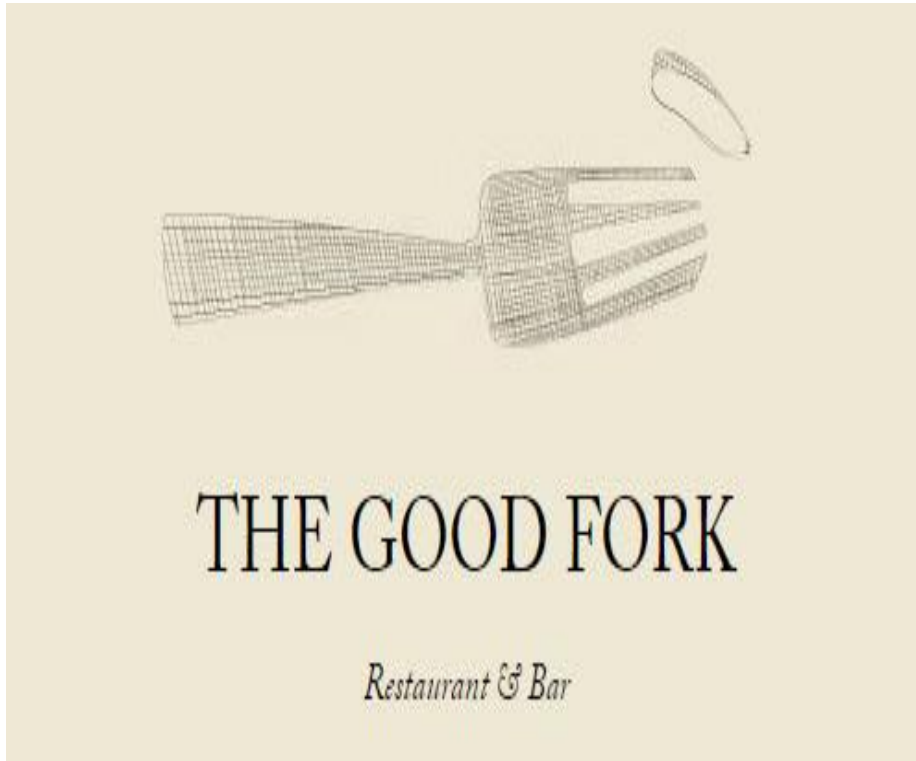


# The Good Fork

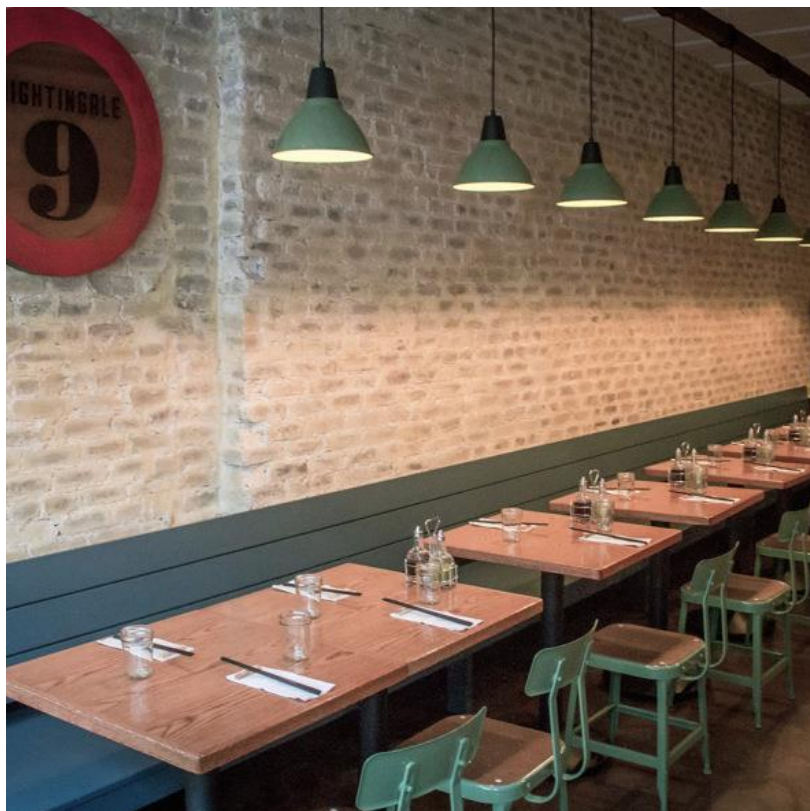
# Whole-Hog Dinner for 8

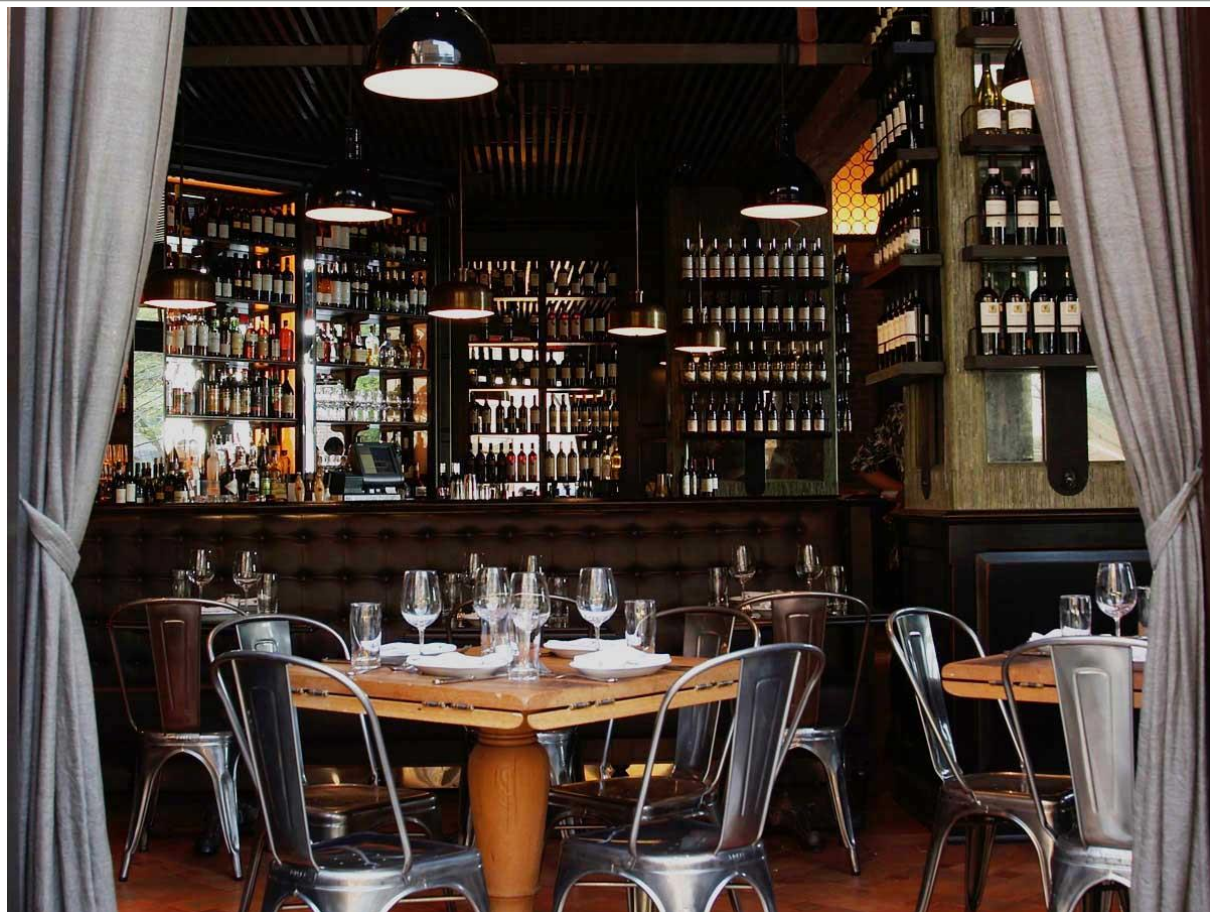
# Dinner for 2 at Nightingale 9

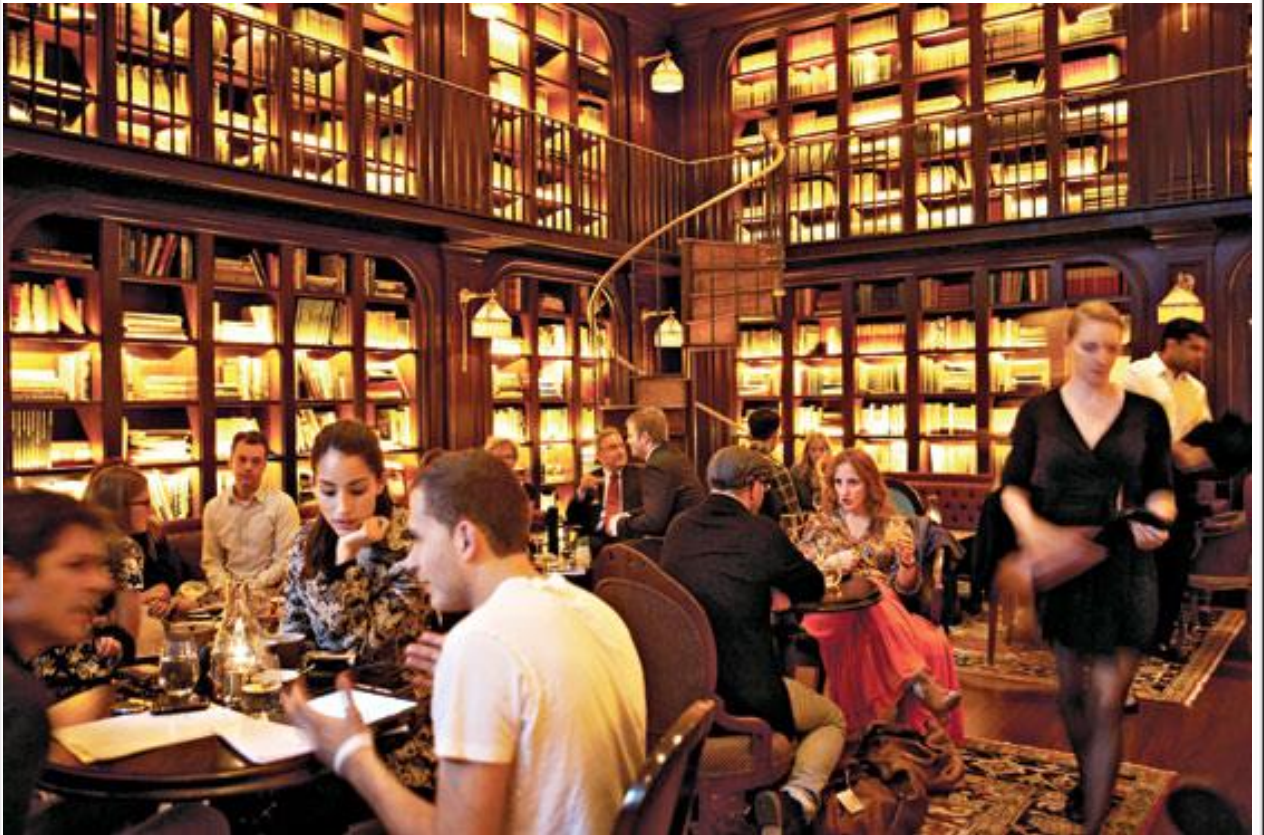
# 2 Tickets to Meatopia
